We start dreaming from childhood. We grow and our dreams become more material, which we call goals.

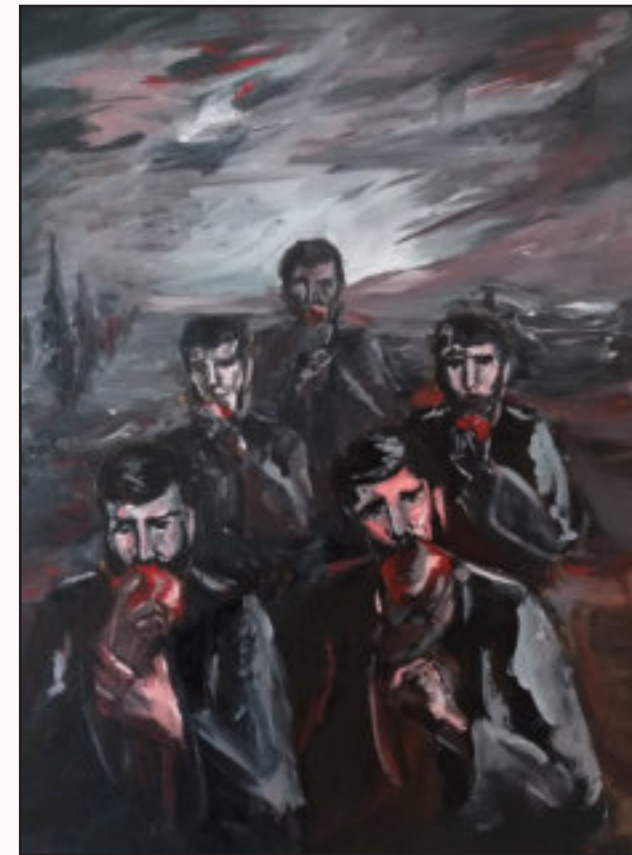
As a child I always wanted to learn to draw.

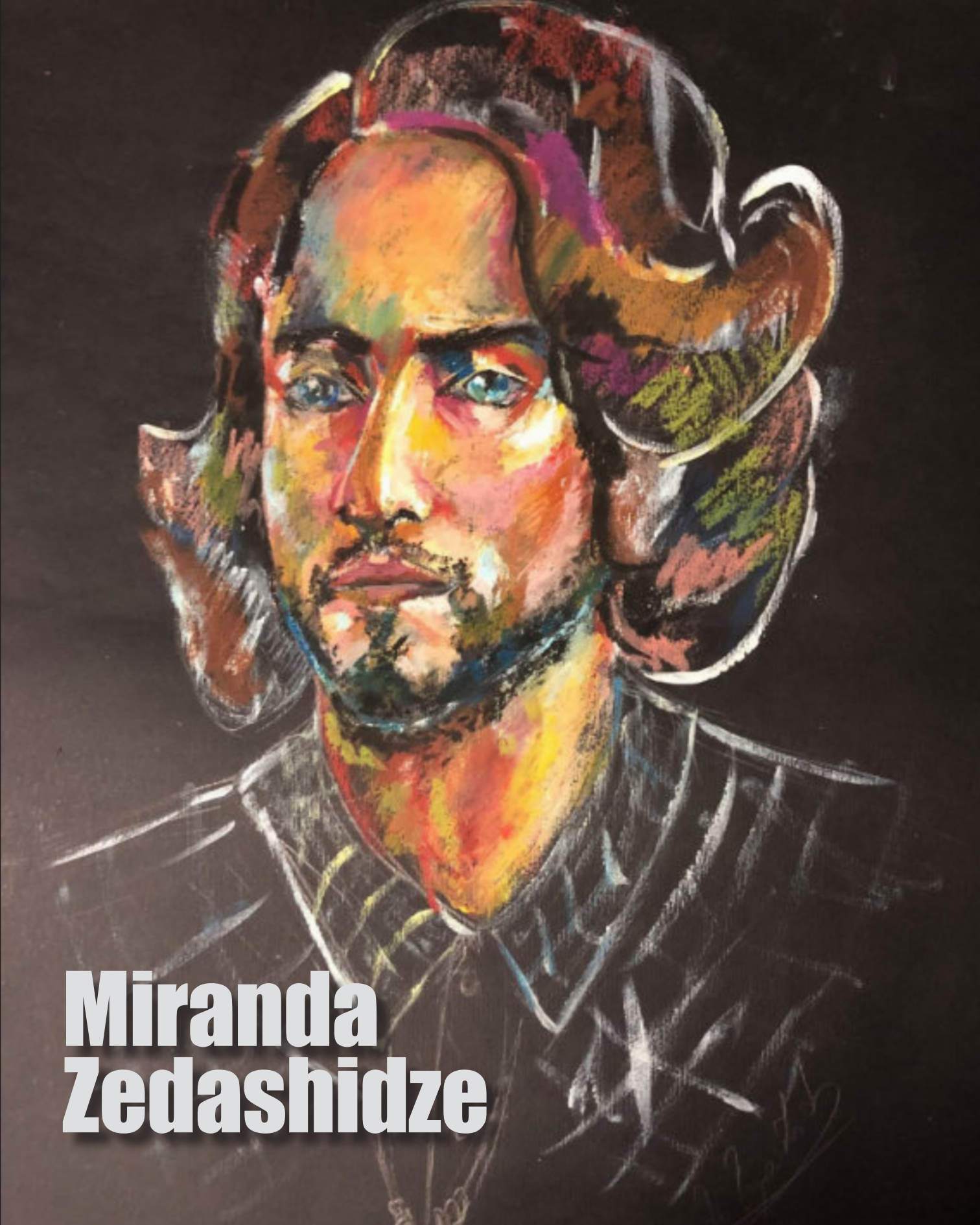
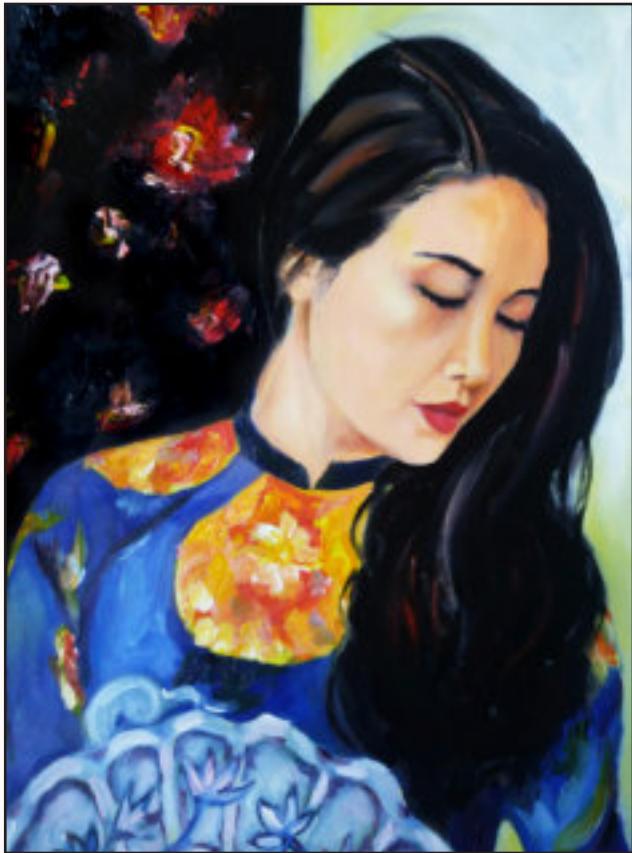
Growing up and drawing is the only thing where I can think freely. Painting is one where I can convey my impression, attitude towards life or stubborn

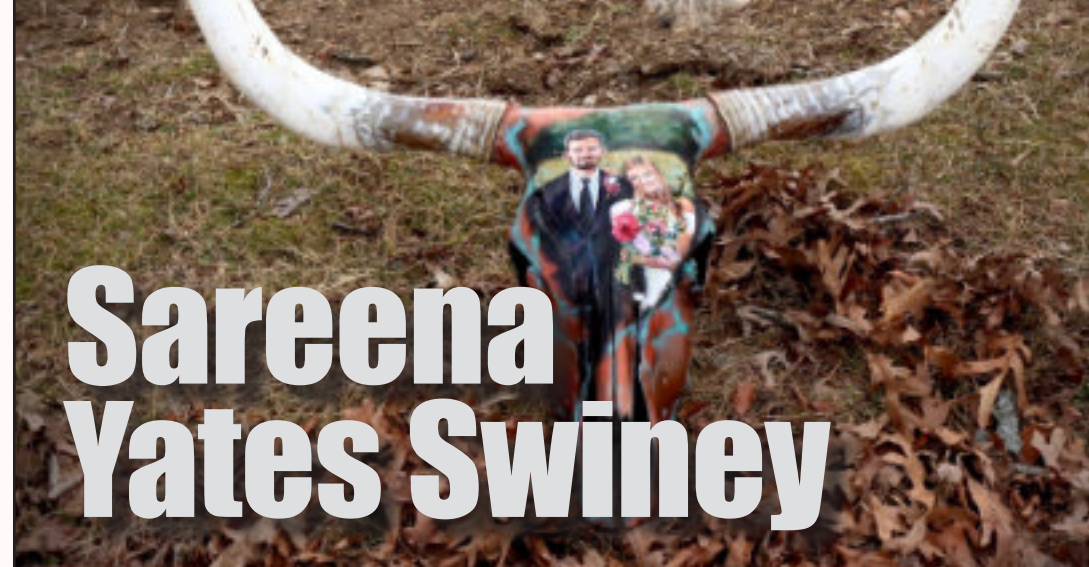

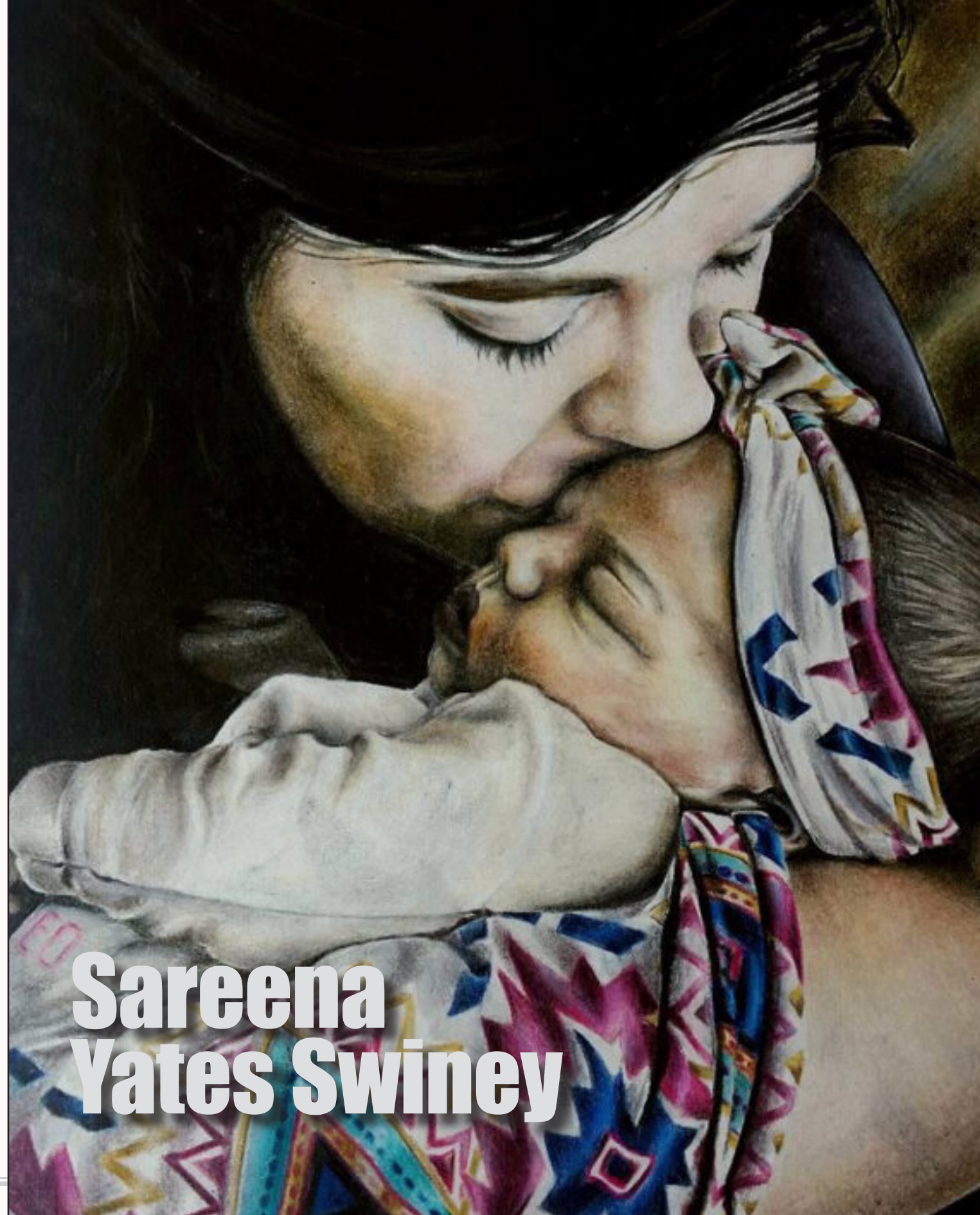
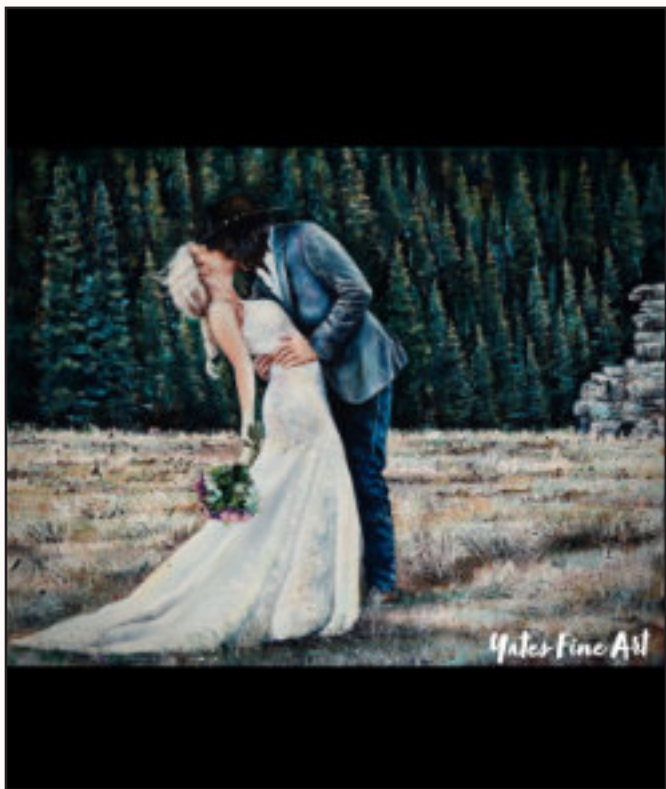
although certain projects required I change my technique, I always reverted back to my same style, seeking that photograph likeness.

I work with professional oil paints, acrylics, watercolors, pastels.

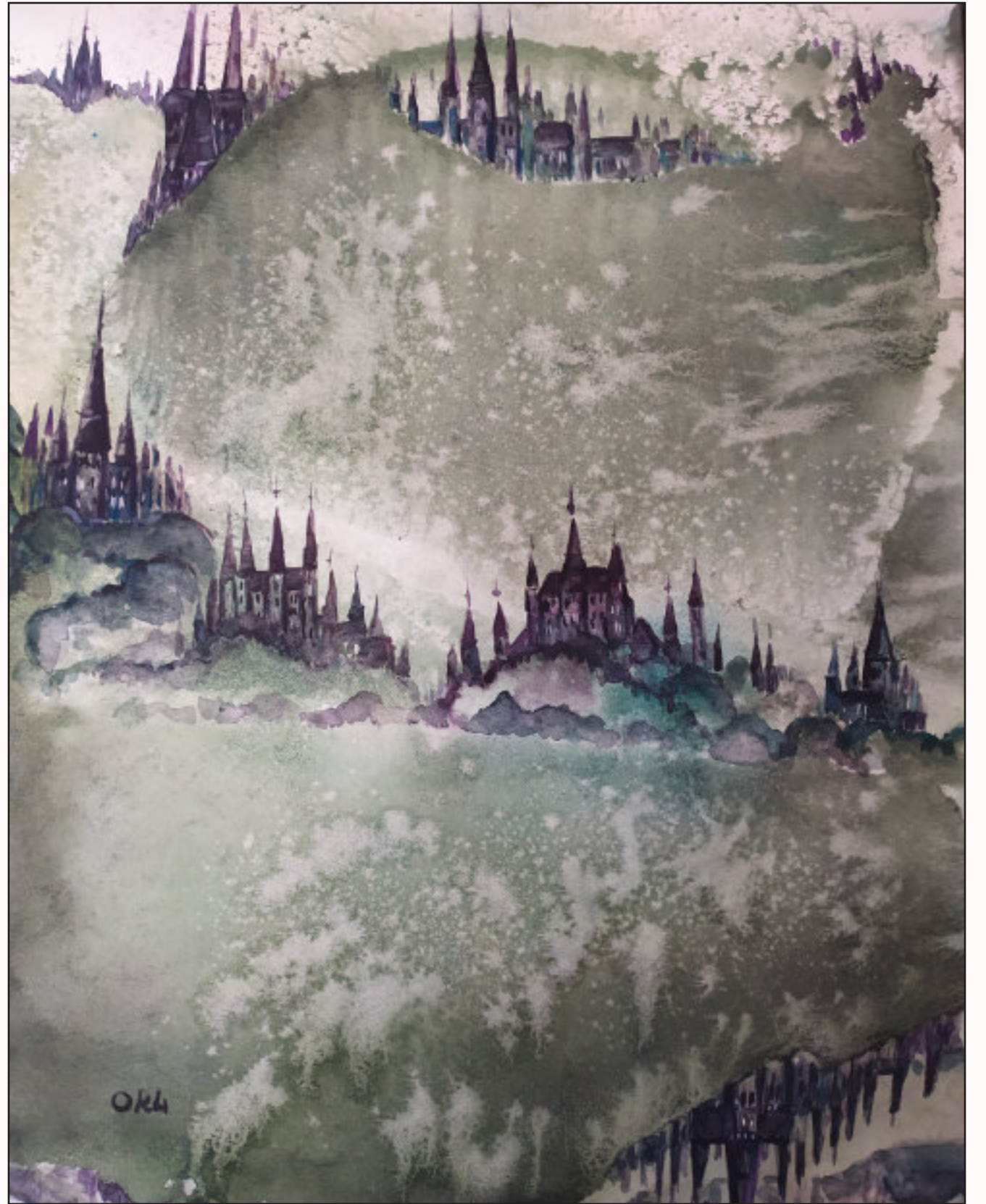

The original paintings are in private collections in Russia, the USA, Canada and Europe.



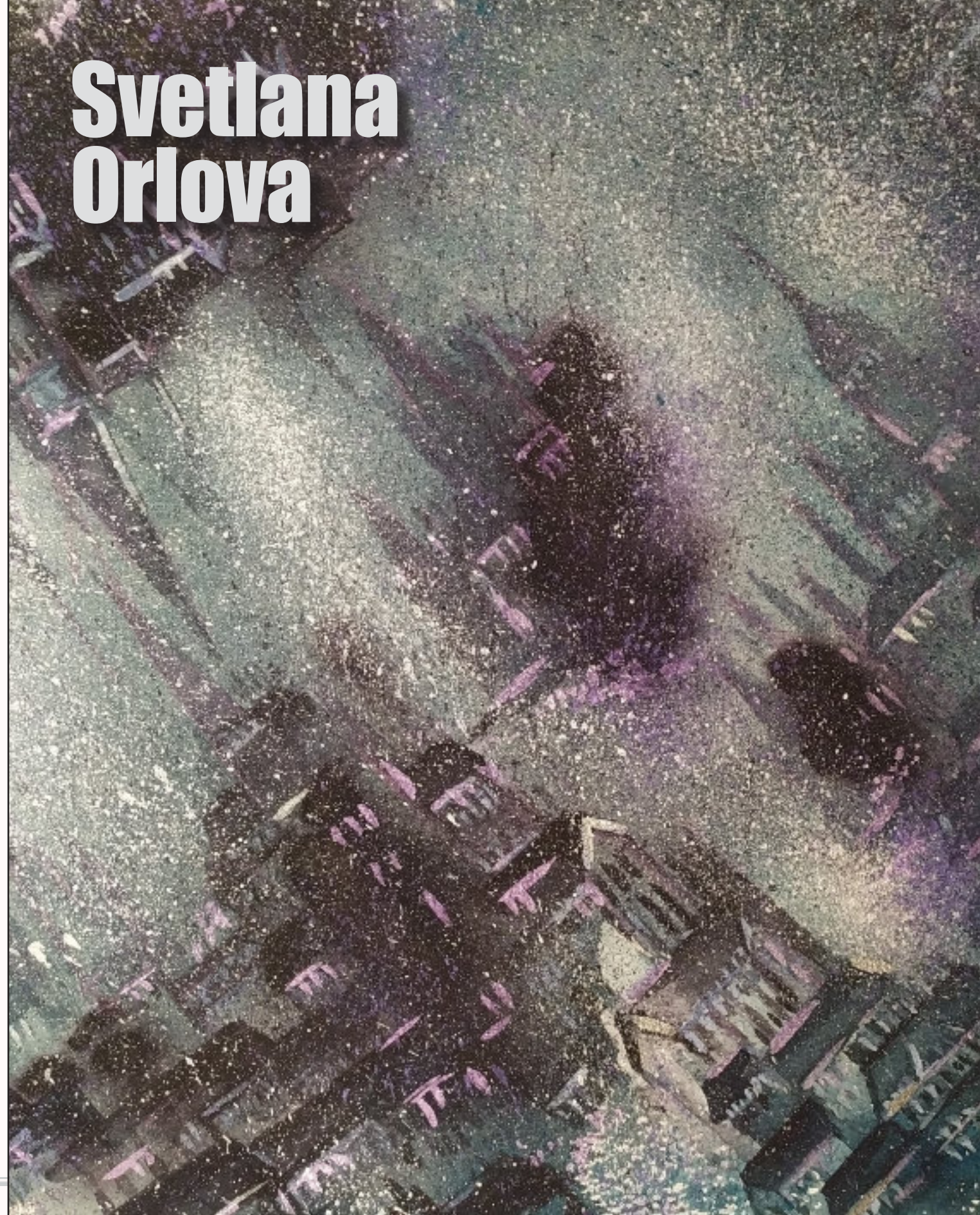

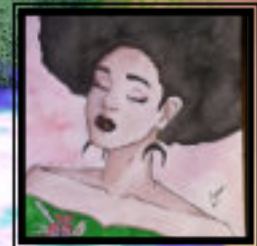
