belt in BJJ, my coaches Sean Martin, Connor Hignet and Connah Martin have taught me so much we have different ways of coaching because of my deafness

















My dream is to become a respected and well known UFC champ. When I am older I hope to inspire kids to continue working toward their dreams because it is possible as






